

Dear Friends,

In our morning Bible Study we've been in the book of Romans.

(Rom 12:1&2 ESV) I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

We have some good conversation on what it means to "not be conformed to this world, but to be transformed by the renewal of your mind." Satan is the master of deception and loves to mislead us by making us think we can live for God and the world too. Satan's lies say things like, "After all, Jesus already paid the penalty for your sins, so don't worry about it, come play in the pleasures of the world and ask for forgiveness later." The trouble is we easily buy into it. We may also come up with that reasoning on our own because of our sin nature. That's where the transforming of minds comes into play. We need to renew our mind and how we think so we can "discern what is the will of God what is good and acceptable and perfect." In order to transform our minds we need to seek, from God's Word, wisdom, knowledge

and understanding. (Pro 2:1-6 ESV) My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you, making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding; yes, if you call out for insight and raise your voice for understanding, if you seek it like silver and search for it as for hidden treasures, then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God. For the LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding;
